SAH is hosting a virtual celebration for our 80th anniversary on Friday, November 13th. The lively FREE online event will feature virtual networking, architect-designed signature cocktails, a silent auction of architectural artifacts and experiences, architectural trivia, and video birthday wishes and memories for SAH and the landmark Charnley-Persky House, SAH's home for the past 25 years.
