### WHO WE ARE

The Society of Architectural Historians (SAH) is a nonprofit membership organization that promotes the study, interpretation and conservation of architecture, design, landscapes and urbanism worldwide.

Founded in 1940, SAH serves a network of local, national and international institutions and individuals who, by profession or interest, focus on the history of the built environment and its role in shaping contemporary life. SAH promotes meaningful public engagement with the history of the built environment through advocacy efforts, print and online publications, and local, national and international programs.

The Charnley-Persky House is recognized as a pivotal work of modern American architecture. Designed by Louis Sullivan with assistance from his junior draftsman, Frank Lloyd Wright, in 1891-92, the Chicago home is listed as a National Historic Landmark and Chicago Landmark. It is open for tours three days per week and hosts both public educational programming and private events.

The building serves as the headquarters of the Society of Architectural Historians, which acquired it in 1995 through a donation from longtime SAH member Seymour Persky. The Charnley Persky Museum Foundation, overseen by a public board, owns and operates the property.
