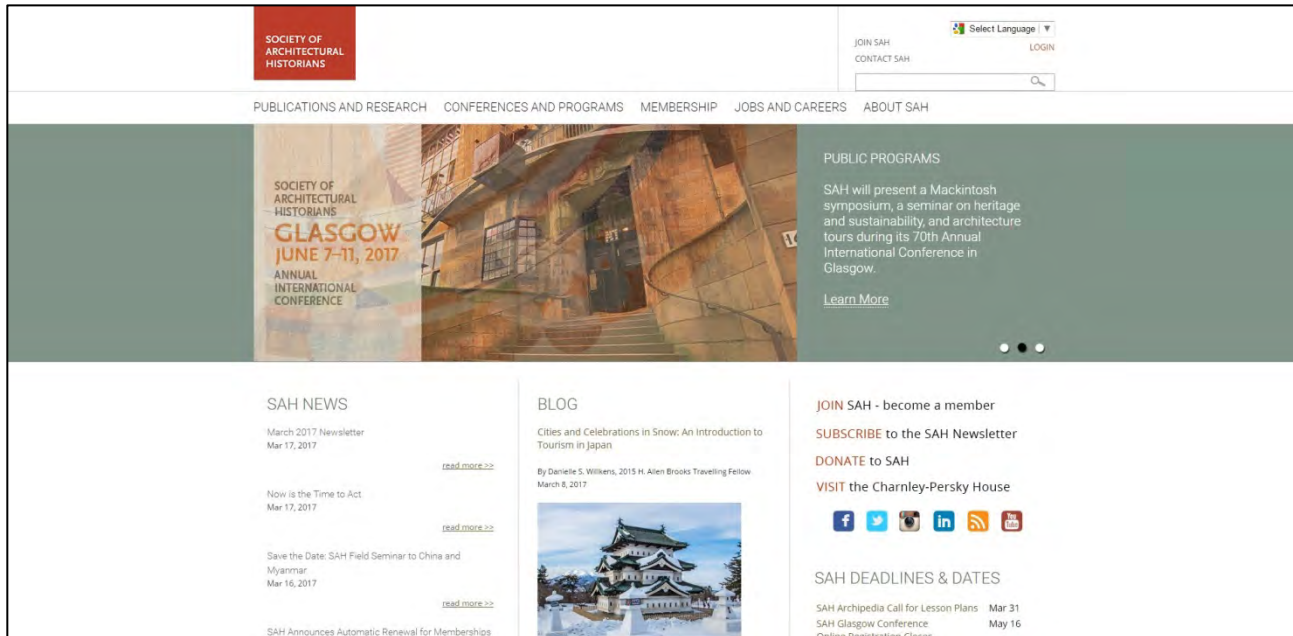
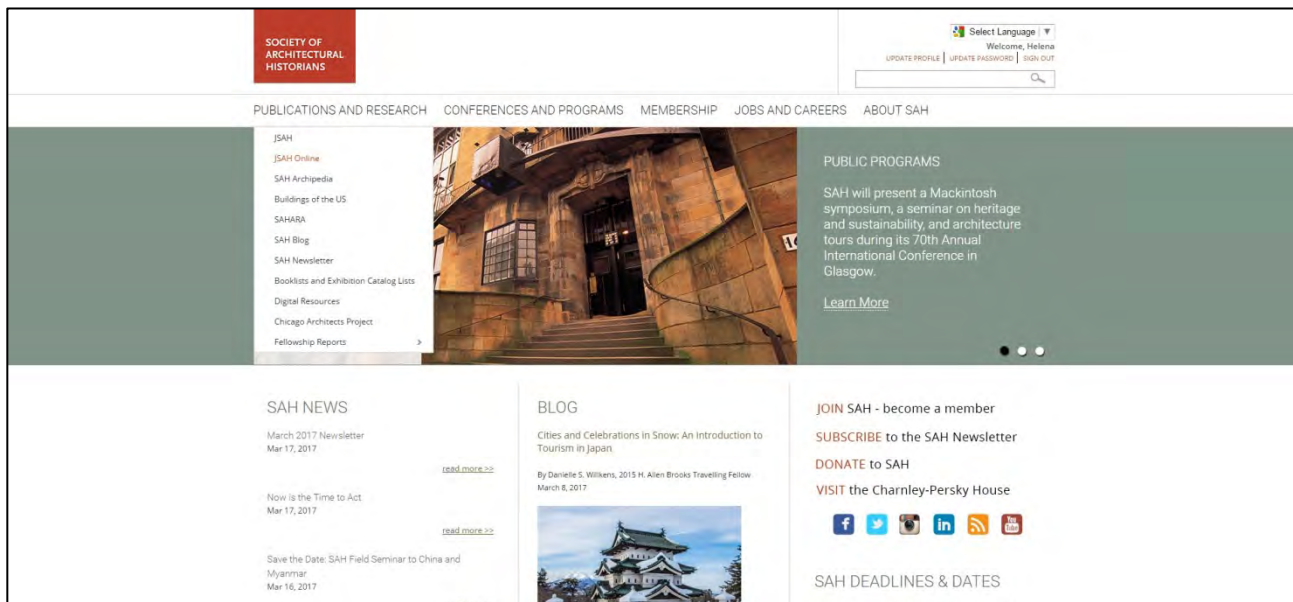


How to Access *JSAH* Online and the *JSAH* Archive

Step 1: Login to the website at sah.org.



Step 2: Select 'JSAH Online' from the Publications and Research menu. (This menu item is only visible to members after logging in.)
